Pat's typical workshop format is:

- Day 1: Starts with a couple of field set-ups. This allows Pat to get a feel for the dogs' trial behavior, handlers' skills and goals.
- Day 2: is likely to start with a review of day one. Pat will take a more active role in managing the challenges
 and corrections chosen. The day will be interspersed with discussions about problem solving and improving
 handler mechanics.
- Day 3: will concentrate more on the individual teams. Pat's increased depth of understanding of both dog
 and handler will allow him to bore in on specific needs. Then he will wrap-up with an emphasis on a training
 plan and a review of lessons learned.

Ron Colyer served as gun captain, making sure at set up that all of the tests were safe, and gunned at both Junior and Senior tests. Roger Pullman worked both days at a pop and throw station which means operating the winger and the popper gun at Junior and Senior. And Pam Pullman carried out marshal duties at Junior with Shari Phillips serving as relief marshal. Kathy Daspit both worked pop and throw and marshaled for the Junior test and marshaled for the Senior tests. Debbie Seames worked a pop and throw station for Junior and also ran Junior test dog. The Objectives of the Evergreen Golden Retriever Club

- a) To preserve the structure, soundness, temperament, natural abilities and personality of the Golden Retriever as described in the breed standard and to do all possible to bring their natural abilities and qualities to perfection.
